Potential students refers to all persons seeking to enrol in a VET unit of study that meets the course requirements under subclause 45(1) of Schedule 1A of the Act and who are, or would be, entitled to VET Student Loan assistance under clause 43 of Schedule 1A of the Act.

Fair Treatment

Design Schools Australia Pty Ltd trading as Sydney Design School will treat fairly all students and potential students.

- a. The selection, from among potential students; and
- b. The treatment of students

Potential students seeking to enrol in a VET unit of study with Design Schools Australia Pty Ltd trading as Sydney Design School, regardless of their background, circumstances or eligibility for funding, will be assessed for entry to study through the same published entry requirements and through the same process.

Selection Criteria

Diploma of Interior Design and Decoration (MSF50213)

Advanced Diploma of Interior Design (MSF60113)

There are no formal entry requirements for the above qualifications, however you will be interviewed by one of our course advisors prior to being offered a place on these courses. Your application will be assessed using the following criteria:

- NSW Higher School Certificate (or equivalent) OR completion of relevant vocational training and/or experience working in a relevant industry and/or
 - Minimum 6 examples of work from HSC design and technology, visual arts, textiles or other design disciplines
 - If you don't meet the above criteria, please prepare a written submission (max 1 x A4 typed page) detailing the reasons why you want to study interior design and what your aspirations are
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International students must attain one of the following minimum standards of proficiency in English: International English Language Testing System (IELTS) 6, Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) 550, Combined Universities Language Test (CULT) 60% or International Second Language Proficiency Rating (ISLPR) 3+, or equivalent.

The above paragraph does not prevent Design Schools Australia Pty Ltd trading as Sydney Design School taking into account, in making decisions mentioned above, educational disadvantages that a particular student or potential student has experienced or the fact that the student or potential student may be enrolled via a VET restricted access arrangement.
