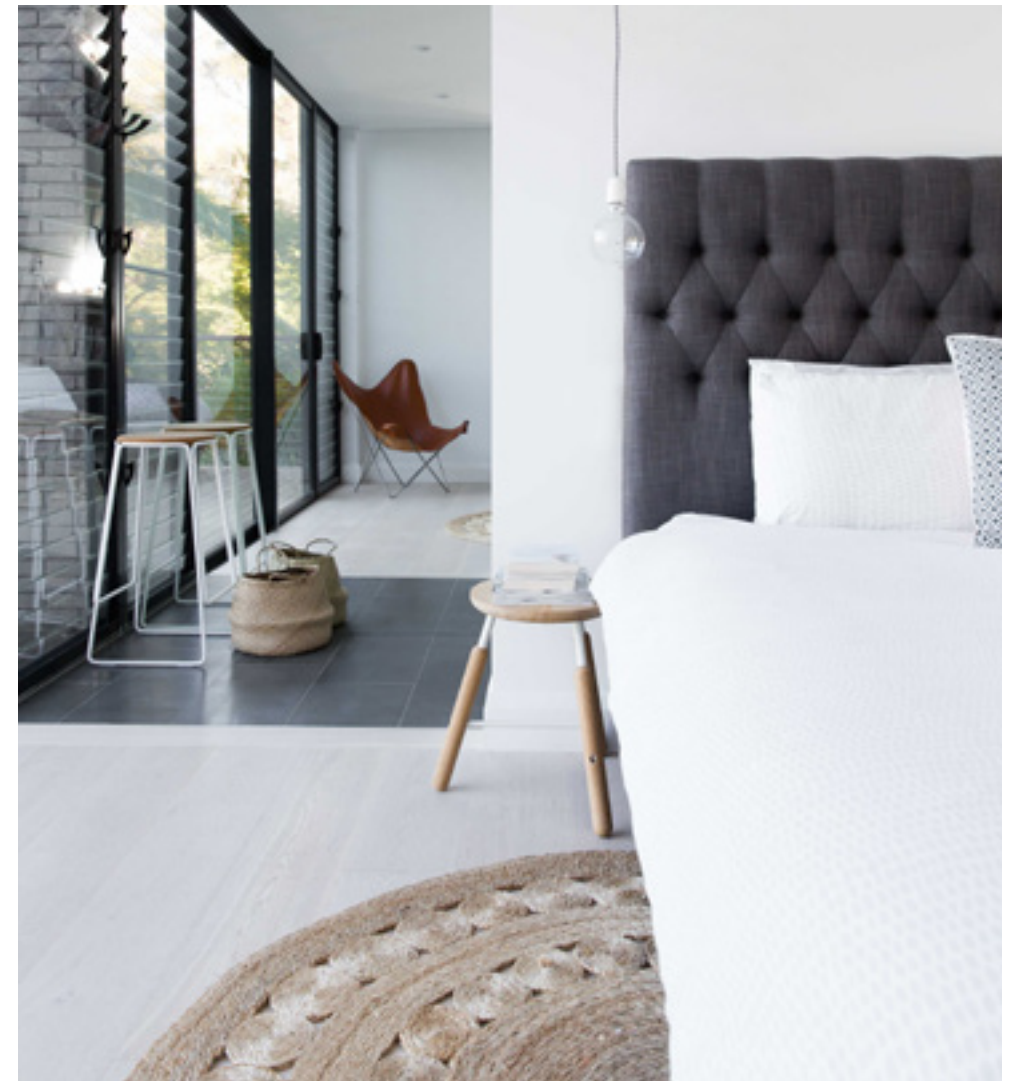

## Ready to enrol?

Simply email your completed and scanned enrolment form, a certified copy of your passport, your portfolio (if you have one) and your motivational statement to our team. If English is your second language you must also provide evidence of an academic IELTS (International English Language Testing System) showing an overall score of at least 6 or equivalent.

We will assess your application and eligibility and request a video call to find out a little more about you, why you are passionate about interiors and to discuss your enrolment in more detail.

## The next step?

If you are offered a place, we will issue a Letter of Offer which you must return signed and pay a deposit of AUD \$2,490. You will then receive a Confirmation of Enrolment which you can use to begin the visa application process.

Prior to commencing your study you will need to provide evidence of your visa and Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC).
